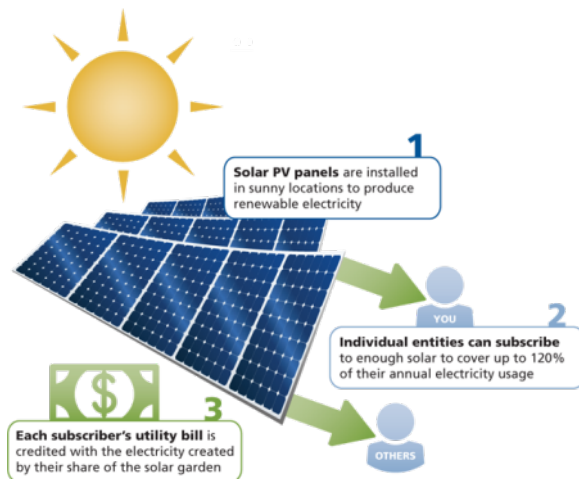

*available through approved contractors currently \$250 in rebates available through Minnesota Power and ComfortSystems*
- Solar Assessments-  
*free through Minnesota Power and Ecolibrium3- free*





2. Prioritize improvements – third party personalized energy efficiency plan. 🏠
3. Identify rebates, loans, and incentives for improvements. 🏠
